There are thousands of stories that could be told. Only they can't be. Due to the sensitive nature of what we deal with it is rare that a client let's us share their story. Like the woman in John 4, an encounter with Jesus changed this one's life.

Scratched. Bleeding. Under the influence of drugs. Words that describe our first encounter with her. She walked in for a pregnancy test eight years ago. The test indicated a negative result. A beautiful young lady caught up in a world she didn't belong in. After she left we went to our knees in prayer seeking answers for how to help her. Weeks later she came back through our door for another pregnancy test. This time a positive result. Followed by weeks of counseling her through the options she was facing. They chose to parent in the midst of addiction and homelessness. They were invited to a local church. They went one Sunday. Then another and another. The church embraced them in the midst of the messiness of their lives. Seeds were planted. Their lives were surrendered to the Lord. They were baptized. The church helped them secure a safe location to live and provided needed supplies for their soon to be born baby girl.

The couple's relationship ended. The boy had given her a baby and a lot of heartache before walking out on her.

Fast forward. Our next encounter with her came several years later. She again found herself in a place that she didn't need to be. She reached out to us asking for "spiritual help". We worked to get her to safety again. Many gospel seeds were planted. Due to distance and circumstances created by the rescue we lost touch with her again.

Fast forward. She reached out to us a couple years later. This time pregnant with a baby boy. Working again to get her life together. In the midst of assisting her, she faced a very scary trial as he was born very prematurely when her body began to experience kidney and liver failure. This time her faith was evident as she learned to pray over him and trust the Lord for his healing as well as her own.

We continue to work with her. She's become like a daughter to us. In the eight years we've been entrusted to love her, she's been through many battles and is more beautiful because of it. She is a great single mom. She works hard to support her little family. She's healing from a lot of past pain, trauma, and heartache. She's now making much better decisions for her children. She's working towards a home through Habitat for Humanity.

From homelessness and addicted to healing and soon to have a beautiful home. God has answered prayer after prayer that we've prayed over her and these children. You've had a major hand in her growth too! If you had not provided the means for us to be here to assist her, I can only imagine where she might have ended up as she walked down the road of poor choices and addiction.

On behalf of all of us, **thank you for giving to the Lord!** We'd love for you to partner with us and with Habitat to help with the building of her home. Her one request as we've talked about the build is that scriptures will be written on the framing as the home is going up and displayed within her home.
